#### **Purpose Collected**

Environmental Health have a duty to assess air quality, maintain a contaminated land register and investigate complaints.

We use this information to investigate incidents and to prepare Annual Reports to Government.

It allows us to take required action to prevent, protect against, or control risks to health arising from industrial activity.

We would also use this information to prevent and detect fraud or other criminal activity.

#### Legal Purpose

We will only use your personal information when the law allows us to. Most commonly we will use your personal information under **Legal Obligation** as the processing is necessary for us to comply with the law namely:

Anti-social Behaviour, Crime & Policing Act 2014 Clean Air Act 1993 Clean Neighbourhoods and Environment Act 2005 Control of Pollution Act 1974 Environment Act 1995 Environmental Protection Act 1990 Water Industry Act 1991

Some of your information may also be used:

- to safeguard adults, and children under the Children's Act 1989
- for the prevention and detection of fraud under Digital Economy Act 2017 (Part 5)

- to assist with debt management or to assist with the collection of money owing to the borough council such as rent, council tax, or other sundry debts
- for the detection and prevention of crime under the Crime and Disorder Act 1998 (Reformed 2014)

### Third Parties we might share information with

We will share your personal information with third parties where required by law or where it is necessary to administer your Housing Benefit, Council Tax Reduction or Second Adult Rebate application. #### How secure is my information with third-party service providers?

All our third-party service providers are required to take appropriate security measures to protect your personal information in line with the GDPR regulations. Our third-party service providers are not permitted to use your personal data for their own purposes. We only permit them to process your personal data for specified purposes and in accordance with our instructions.

Your personal data is processed (including storage) within the European Economic Area only.
