Purpose Collected

We collect this information to process your grant application or tender submission, provide administration for award panels and for payment for successful tenders or applications.

We will use it to monitor performance of the grant or tender process and to ensure you are meeting your obligation under the tender or grant conditions including key performance indicators.

We will use it to communicate with you regarding contact you have had with us and to document your relationship with us.

We may use some of your personal information to publicise grants we have awarded or services we have commissioned through press releases and social media. All awarded grants are published on our website. The information includes the name of the organisation or person (where individuals have applied), amount of grant awarded and the details of the project funded.

With your consent, we will use your information to inform you of grant funding opportunities.

Legal Purpose

We will only use your personal information when the law allows us to. Most commonly we will use your personal information under **Contract** for grant awards and tender awards.

We will only process your information for marketing with your **Consent**. You can remove your consent at any time by contacting Tamworth Borough Council.

We also may use the personal information you provide us for the prevention and detection of fraud under Digital Economy Act 2017 (Part 5)

Third Parties we might share information with

We will share your personal information with third parties where required by law, where it is necessary to administer grant application or where you have consented for us to do so. Examples of the organisations we may need to share information with are below, this list is not exhaustive:

Third-Parties Service Providers – Which third parties process my personal information?

How secure is my information with third-party service providers?

All our third-party service providers are required to take appropriate security measures to protect your personal information in line with the GDPR regulations. Our third-party service providers are not permitted to use your personal data for their own purposes. We only permit them to process your personal data for specified purposes and in accordance with our instructions.
