# **Purpose Collected**

With your consent we use your personal information as part of our consultation database inform you of consultations run by the planning policy team. You can remove your consent to be on this database at any time.

We use information you give us to formulate Local Plans which determine land use and planning policy for Tamworth, revisions to the Statement of Community Involvement, a statutory document which we produce to show how we will engage the community in the planning process, for fulfilling our legal duties in relation to the production of Neighbourhood Plans. When you submit comments to a consultation your name and your comments will be made public. All other personal information will be held confidentially. We may need to share your personal information (name and contact details) with the Planning Inspectorate so that they can contact you to enable you to participate in the examination process.

We also use personal information to process Call for Sites submissions, The Brownfield Land Register, Conservation Area Appraisals and Management Plans, and Community Infrastructure Levy Charging Schedule.

## **Legal Purpose**
