Rest and Relaxation

You will find an array of seating dotted about the Pleasure Grounds in which to sit, meet friends or watch nature at play. The beautiful lawns make an ideal spot for a picnic or just letting the children run and play.

Reflective seating area Beautiful granite stone seating in the corner of the lower lawn, perfect for quiet contemplation and watching the world go by.

Queen's Diamond Jubilee Rose Garden and seating area Unveiled in July 2012, this beautiful wrought iron crown was built to commemorate the Diamond Jubilee of Queen Elizabeth II. It is adorned with magnificent Prince William roses in summer and is the perfect place to sit and be intoxicated with the wonderful scent of roses.



Take a Break Pavilion Café

Open seven days a week, serving a wide selection of hot and cold food to eat in or take away. You can either sit in the cosy tea room or outside on the large patio area next to the counter selling freshly-made ice-creams.

The Planet Walk was the brainchild of Tamworth's Town Twinning Association who came up with the idea as a way to commemorate the millennium. The walk is based on a similar trail created in our twinned town Bad Laasphe, in Germany.

The trail is the work of internationally renowned artist Walenty Pytel, who created the Sun and nine planets in his studio near Ross-on-Wye. He created the Colin Grazier Statue in St. Editha's Square. He also has work positioned at the entrance to Birmingham International Airport and outside the House of Commons.

The walk takes approximately 15 minutes and is easily navigated by young and old alike, just follow the red rockets laid into the path. Distances between the planets on the trail have been worked out to represent relative distances between the planets in the Solar System.

So doing the Planet Walk will give you a feel for how the solar system is organised in our particular corner of the galaxy.







Flowers and Nature

The floral terraces are a sight to behold with magnificent blooms of colour throughout the year. Look out for the special six-foot high floral features.

The Castle Grounds are also home to many species of wildlife including birds, ducks, geese, squirrels and voles even foxes can sometimes be seen.



Play

For children up to the age of 14 who love nothing better than tearing around and climbing, don't miss the enclosed outdoor adventure park with its famous giant pirate ship.

Entertainment

The Castle Grounds is home to Tamworth's annual outdoor events programme including medieval jousting on St George's Day, a full Saxon encampment on Heritage Festival weekend and as many live music events.
