

Annotated nomination papers – UK Parliamentary election

Introduction

- 1.1 The nominations process is a key element in the administration of elections, and at scheduled elections there can be numerous nomination papers to process from multiple candidates/agents with varying levels of experience.
- This document, which includes annotated nomination forms, has been produced as a guide for Acting Returning Officers (ARO) in England and Wales, Returning Officers (RO) in Scotland, their deputies/deputes, and any staff appointed to assist with the checking of nomination papers. The notes cover points that commonly cause confusion or difficulty, which staff can refer to when checking that a nomination paper is completed properly.
- 1.3 The examples given in this document take account of changes to legislation taking place **on or after 2 May 2024.**

2 Process and forms

- 2.1 Generally, there are three documents that all candidates must submit to make their nomination valid:
 - Nomination form
 - Home Address form
 - Consent to nomination

These forms must be delivered by hand, must be originals not copies and anything received by email/fax will not be valid.

- 2.2 Candidates standing on behalf of a registered political party will also need to submit:
 - a certificate of authorisation
 - an emblem request form (if they want an emblem on the ballot paper)

These can be delivered by hand or by post but must be originals and anything received by email/fax will not be valid.

- 2.3 UK Parliamentary candidates also need to pay a deposit of £500. The (A)RO will have provided instructions about how this could be paid, for example in cash or by banker's draft.
- 2.4 Candidates may also submit an election agent appointment form, which is not required to determine their nomination, and does not necessarily need to be submitted at the same time as the other nomination forms. However, it does have the same deadline. Where a candidate does not submit an agent appointment form, they will become their own election agent by default.
- 2.5 An election agent in a county constituency may appoint sub-agents to act on their behalf. No sub-agents can be appointed in a borough (or burgh) constituency. The appointment of sub-agents must be in writing to the (A)RO no later than two days prior to the poll.
- 2.6 Any issues which are unclear when processing nominations must be escalated to the (A)RO.
- 2.7 It is good practice to informally check nomination papers before their formal submission. This can allow candidates or agents to make any corrections or complete new nomination forms as necessary.



- 2.8 After informally checking nomination papers, and any issues have been addressed, candidates should be invited to formally submit the nomination paper. It is at that point that staff should record the date and time received, and number the form(s) in the order in which they are submitted.
- 2.9 If a candidate is validly nominated by more than one form, they may request that the details of their proposers, seconders and other subscribers for up to two more valid nomination forms be added to the statement of persons nominated. As such, the statement should have space to enable the names of up to 30 subscribers to be added if requested.
- 2.10 Once a nomination has been formally submitted a candidate cannot amend any details. But if a candidate changes their mind and they no longer want to stand for election, they can withdraw within the time for the delivery of nomination papers at the election.




4 Annotated forms

4.1 These annotated forms cover areas that commonly cause confusion or difficulty, which staff can refer to when checking that a nomination paper is completed properly. Notes have been added to draw attention to the areas where candidates may have questions or made errors, and to remind staff where they need to add details.



Form 1a - Nomination paper (header)



A candidate may deliver multiple nomination forms, up to a maximum of three. Confirm the order in which they want the forms to appear on the Statement of Persons Nominated.



Form 1a - Nomination paper (Candidate's details)

The Candidate's details section must be completed in full before any electors sign the nomination paper

Full names must be added here – no initials. Prefixes (e.g., Sir) or suffixes (e.g., Snr) must not be used.

We, the undersigned, being electors for the said Constituency, do hereby nominate the undermentioned person as a candidate at the said election

The description may be left blank.

OR the candidate could use the description 'Independent'.

OR - for political party candidates, they would need to enter the registered party name or description as authorised by the party. This must be as registered with the <u>Electoral Commission</u>, and must match **EXACTLY** with the description authorised on Form 2 – the Certificate of Authorisation.

OR the Speaker of the House of Commons can use the following description: "The Speaker seeking re-election".

It is important to read the <u>EC</u> (A)RO Guidance if a description is used.

This is optional.

If the candidate is commonly known by a different name to their actual name, this/these should be entered here.

Or, if they use one or more of their names given on the nomination paper in a different manner (e.g. if they are known by their middle name), they should enter it here.

The commonly used name will then appear on the ballot paper and the Statement of Persons Nominated (SOPN) instead of the actual name.

Usually, you will take the commonly used name at face value, but it may be rejected if it is obscene or offensive, or its use could mislead or confuse electors.

It is important to read the <u>EC (A)RO</u> Guidance if a commonly used name is used.

The candidate should include the polling district reference and elector number from the register in force when the Notice of Election (NOE) is published.

The form must be signed by registered electors, a proposer, seconder and 8 assentors from the constituency.

Prior to the publication of the NOE, you can assist candidates/agents with elector numbers providing they tell you the full name and address of the subscribers.


Each subscriber must sign the nomination form in the signature column. Their name may be printed too, preferably in capitals and does not have to match the name as printed in the register. If this column is not completed it does not invalidate the nomination.

The details of the subscribers should be input into the election management software to check that they are registered.

The candidate can choose to give the name of the UK Parliamentary constituency OR the relevant area in which their home address is situated (if their home address is in the UK), OR, if they live outside the UK, the country in which their home address is situated.

The relevant area is the county/district/London borough/county borough/local government area/local government district (as appropriate) in which the home address is situated.

For example, if the candidate's home address is in the Southmarsh District Council area, the name of the relevant area is 'Southmarsh'.

In this example, the candidate is using the name of the constituency.

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Where the candidate signs or someone else (other than the election agent) signs on the candidate's behalf, the election agent must sign the confirmation of acceptance.

If the election agent signs on behalf of the candidate, they do not need to also sign the acceptance.

Candidates who appoint themselves as an agent, but are withholding their home address from the ballot paper and also do not want it to appear on the Notice of Election Agents, could provide an office address which is different to their home address.

Form 4 – Sub-agent notification form

Optional – in a county constituency only, election agents may appoint individual sub-agents for particular parts of the constituency, as long as those parts do not overlap. The election agent can determine the parts into which they wish to sub-divide the constituency.
