

Lots of litter about, very little done about weeds growing everywhere in the summer


Plenty of facilities, lots of green spaces

Great service with one phone call


It's said TBC ask for people's views, perhaps you need to give proof you do listen and act

I don't think it's better or worse than anywhere else


The proportion of money going to the borough is limited

I feel the council should focus more on supporting local small businesses and restoration of landmarks


Time will tell with the town regeneration project, but always hopeful

On the whole, TBC serves the town well, employing local people who care deeply about how their town looks


Because you don't solve the real problems of the community

I believe the council takes local concerns very seriously and in my view acts upon those as best it can


Plenty of problems with litter that has been highlighted by residents but no action taken

Good amount of events in town centre, but need more in outer areas, like Amington


The areas I've lived in have all had a communal feel about them

Lighting is not within your remit, but some roads have poor lighting and lack of police is a problem


I think crime has increased in Tamworth since I used to walk home alone all the time, but no so much now

Drug dealers everywhere


Tamworth is safer to live in than most towns

This is a problem in Tamworth. We are not very diverse or open unfortunately.


I'm black and I think it's quite friendly, not as friendly as Polesworth, Dordon and Atherstone though

You will always get people who moan and do nothing about it


The residents in my area have certainly come together during covid and we are hoping this will continue

Volunteers litter picking and maintaining local nature reserve often seen. Council workers also good at maintaining area and generally very friendly


There are some very active local groups and I have a lot of respect for them. Most people live in their own bubble. We fit into that category.

Thinking about your local area, how much of a problem do you think these are?




Do you have access to the internet?




How do you access it? (select all that apply)




Has your internet use changed since the start of the pandemic?




If you use the internet, how confident are you using it for the following?








Finding a website you have visited before








If you use the internet, how confident are you using it for the following?









And for which reasons did you visit the website?




How satisfied or dissatisfied were you with the website overall?




Have you had cause to contact TBC in the last: (select one that applies)



Have you ever wanted to make contact with the council and not been able to?




If unable to make contact, for which reasons? Please select all that apply.



Please select the top three channels you have used to contact TBC in the past





Please select your top three preferred methods for contacting TBC






Has your ability to contact the council changed since the pandemic, for example due to offices closure?






Have you been unable to get an issue resolved/access help you need due to the reception closure at Marmion House?

I believe the council should work alongside the town more, canvassing younger opinions, business etc


I think you should publish a residents' magazine to be made available to all residents and businesses


Hardly ever see any communications from the council. Twice a year with council tax details and green bin fee.

I'm all for removing paper-based contact and replacing with digital communications


How do you currently find out about TBC and the services it provides? (Select all that apply)

I would urge the council to engage with the Next Door social media site


Like to know about what's going on and how the council is performing
